





# Our Story

**The Closet Company** (soon after changed to “**Kamloops Klosets**”) was established in 1989 when Doug Sherwood, an ambitious husband and father, brought his young family from Vancouver to the Okanagan to strike out on his own by starting his own closet company. With enough experience gained while working for someone else in the industry, he saw an opportunity to take this new European cabinet hanging system and help people simplify their lives through organization.



No matter how much closet space we already have, we always seem to need more. It must be one of the famous Murphy's laws.

That's probably what inspired Doug Sherwood to create The Closet Company. Doug specializes in organizing "dead space" closets, nooks and crannies, all those areas in homes and apartments that don't seem to do anything but take up space without doing anything for it.

"I can double the useable space in any closet," says Doug. "Using this system, and the techniques we've developed, we'll at least triple any shelving, and give about 50 per cent more hanging space." Now there's a blow to Murphy's Law.

The Closet Company carries the Lee/Rowan ventilated shelving system. This wire shelf system is extremely economical in comparison with wood, and carries a 15-year warranty. The baked-on epoxy finish, just like the finish on your fridge and stove, is virtually maintenance-free and attracts very little dust.

How economical is it?

"We can do a typical three-bedroom house, including linen closets and walk-ins in the bedrooms, for from \$300 to \$700. That would probably be less than a contractor would charge for a less effective, less durable closet system." Doubling the space in a six-foot closet could run as little as \$70.

Doug works with contractors and home-builders now, and will gladly give free estimates for new homes or renovations. All he needs is a few minutes of your time and a chance to take some measurements.

Double Cabinet Instructions

1. Lay gables carefully on the floor with protection like cardboard or a blanket

2. Insert Push-in Dowels

Push-in Dowel

Approx 38-40" from bottom hole - put door next gable to see where the middle hinge will be installed

\*4th hole from bottom

20 in

3. Install Hinge Plates

Hinge Plate

Flip this gable and install push-in dowel to match push-in's on right side panel

Flip middle gable and place hinge plates to match hinge holes in doors

For placement of middle plate - line up with one of the doors. May be different from a left to a right side by one set of hole up or down

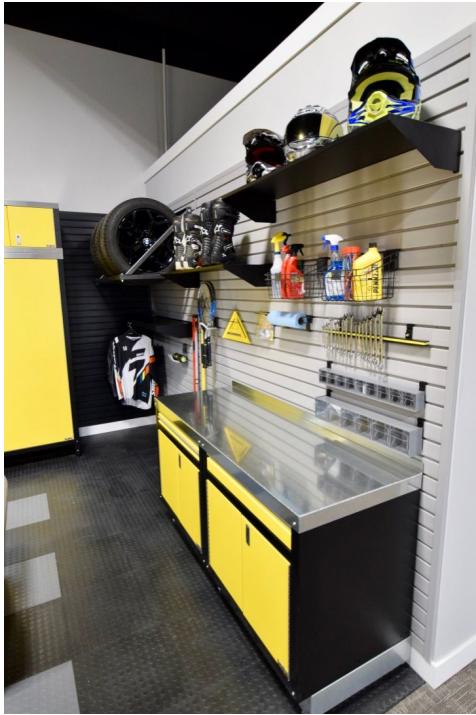
